Major HFHAS project was delivered in Lebanon, supporting the renovation of the Rosary Sisters Hospital. The Hospital property and some staff suffered serious damage after the explosion in Beirut on 04 August 2020.



The Rosary Sisters Hospital is a 200-bed hospital in the Gemmayze neighborhood of Beirut with 160 employees and 140 physicians. The Hospital location is near the port of Beirut, less than 500 meters from both detonations of explosives. It is well known in the region to be a Catholic Humanitarian Mission supervised by the Holy See.
